1. **Grace** to a **Sin**ning Brother 1a

2. **Grace** in the **Helping Brother** 1b-5

1. **Grace** to a **Sinning Brother** 1a

When? He is “overtaken” in a “fault”

- Fall into sin

1. **Grace** to a **Sin**ning Brother 1a

What? “Restore”

- Not judgment
- Not criticism
- Not gossip
- How would you want to be treated?

1. **Grace** to a **Sinning Brother** 1a

What? “Restore”

- Mend a broken bone
- Stand up straight again
- Put back in the right way

2. **Grace** in the **Helping Brother** 1b-5

Who? The “spiritual” ones

How? In “meekness”

Caution: Avoiding “temptation”

2. **Grace** in the **Helping Brother** 1b-5

Action : “Bearing” in “love”

Humility: Not “deceiving self”

Integrity: “Prove own work”

Responsibility: “Bear own burden”

Does **Verse 2** disagree with **Verse 5**?

Verse 2 = a heavy, weighty burden

Verse 5 = a light, personal burden

Hebrews 5:2
